As part of the new legislative framework, the European Al Act will take care of technological innovations and details through the use of (harmonized) standards. However, as has been repeatedly observed, in standardization, there is a lack of participation of stakeholders from civil society. With this workshop, we intend to approach this issue from different disciplinary angles to discover how overlooked groups and groups that usually do not have a prominent voice in standardization can be included. We are broadening this inquiry to Al governance, regulation, and Al development in general. Our questions range from sustainability questions, environmental inequality, Al and education, Al and children's rights, and how fundamental rights impacts can be assessed to critical theory and fairness.
